Naval Company Inc is looking for fresh, technically current photos of various line gun applications and is therefore presenting this photo contest. The person or company who provides the **"BEST "SET of 10" or more BRIDGER™ LINE THROWING GUN PHOTOS"** that can be used by Naval Company Inc in a PowerPoint® for training and/or on their website or elsewhere, will win a **\$500 CREDIT** toward the purchase of a **CG85PEL, Bridger™ Line Throwing Gun kit in a Pelican® Case**, or **50% OFF** the retail price of one order of supplies, excluding a complete kit - whichever you choose. Please understand there will only be one winner, however, we don't anticipate more than 10 - 20 entrants, so your odds are excellent! We will acknowledge on our website those who contributed and announce the winner as soon as one has been determined.

RULES, REGULATIONS and CRITERIA: Contest entries must include completed entry form. Any Bridger™ Line Throwing Gun owner, dealer, want-to-be owner or *individual may enter photos. Photos must be digital, of high quality, in .jpg format, and in some way apply to use of a Bridger™ Line Throwing Gun; the more informative and/or illustrative of line gun use, the better. At least 4 of the 10 (or more) photos must have the line throwing gun or line gun supplies in the photo. Other photos could include a before and after photo of a project that required the line gun for completion. The winning set of photos "must" be informative and of quality suitable for use in a PowerPoint or on the website. If someone would like to enter more than once, entries can be submitted in sets of 10 or more photos. Thus, 20 photos would count as two entries. However, each "set of 10" must stand alone and be capable of being judged for quality and instructional or marketing value merit. One set could be a specific application; one set could be solely instructional. Each submission must include a separate entry form. Photos may be altered to include remarks or include other marks to aid in instruction or understanding provided the unaltered photos are additionally included. An alternative option for entry would be a digital video of 5 minutes or longer in length showing successful use of the Bridger™ Line Throwing Gun in a rescue or function of value. This video must be suitable for application on a DVD and/or the internet. If you already have a video that could be entered but isn't long enough. Add an interview with the person who facilitated the line throwing gun success and/or a person who was rescued or valued from its' use.

Types of photos needed: Fire trucks and firefighters in firefighting or rescue gear; ice rescue photos; mud rescue photos; whitewater steep creek applications; lowhead dam rescue photos, tug to ship photos; drilling rig to ship photos; deep ravine; river rescue lines; utility company applications; oil spill clean-up, bridge applications; safe storage photos; shooting safety gear; unusual applications (i.e...ham radio antenna building); challenges where it could be dangerous to use the Bridger and notations why; success stories of the past with photo of the survivor and rescuers, etc. We are sure you have the best ideas of what would be of value.
