

August 1, 2008: 325' Shot Line RECALL

The 325' – 310 lb test tan shot line used with the with Bridger™ line throwing gun has been recalled. This line, also purchased as **SL325T** or **L-SL325T**, can be identified by the designations “**325 FT**” and “**310 LB. TEST**” stamped on the outside of the fiberboard shot line container. No other length of line is affected by this recall.

Although this line has been used for over 40 years without any complaint or reported instance of the line not working as intended, our own recent testing has alerted us to a possible issue. **Do not use these lines for life saving or any other critical purpose; the Bridger™ line gun may, under certain circumstances, outshoot the length of the line, leaving the rescuers without a rescue line.** Naval Company Inc is conducting a mailing direct to dealers and consumers. If you possess one of these 325' shot lines and have not received a recall letter as of yet, to ensure they are not used, **remove these lines from your kit or storage room immediately** and **DO NOT USE THEM.**
